

Virtual Volunteer French Language Tutor

The Redwood's emergency shelter is seeking a virtual French Language Tutor to volunteer once a week supporting one of the residents. Volunteering remotely via Zoom, you and the resident will work together to attain their goal of learning the French written and spoken language.

As a French Language Tutor, your role will include: working together to create a learning plan that accommodates their learning style (visual/oral/audio), practice the written and oral French language, seek out and/or request tools to aid in the success of learning, all through a trauma-informed, anti-racist, and anti-oppression framework.

Dates: Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday (flexible in day, starting as soon as possible).

Time: 10:30am-11:30am

Location: Remote via Zoom

Duties Include:

- Lead virtual French Language Tutoring session once a week. Potential for multiple sessions per week in agreement with the volunteer, resident, and Volunteer Coordinator.
- Work alongside the resident to formulate a learning plan.
- Inform the supervisor of any materials needed to assist in the lessons.
- Provide encouragement when difficulties arise.
- Be present and open to what is shared.
- Practice confidentiality.

What you need:

- French language skills.
- Consistent availability.
- Ability to follow instruction and show a high level of organization.
- Flexibility.
- Ability to volunteer in a virtual setting.
- Strong decision making and de-escalation skills.
- Positive and constructive communication style. Compassion and empathy are key!
- Knowledge of trauma and the impact of gender-based violence is an asset.

Qualifications:

- Must provide, or be able to apply for, a Vulnerable Sector Check (within the years 2022-2025) from your local police service.
- Experience working with adults learning new skills is an asset.
- Must have a strong command of both the English and French languages.
- Must be over 19 years of age.
- Provide 2 references to be contacted by the Volunteer Coordinator.



Training:

Must be able to attend virtual training provided by The Redwood's Volunteer Coordinator.
